TOUR PROGRAMME:

SATURDAY 25TH MAY 2024

Entrants should ensure fuel tanks are full as there may not be fuel in Hill End.

Registration will be at the Majellan Bowling Club 136 Keppel St Bathurst from 8.30am where you will collect your Tour bag. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided.

Departing Bathurst at 9.30am the Tour will be approximately 155 kms travelling to the **Gold Rush Towns** of **Sofala** and **Hill End** returning to Bathurst via **Turondale**. The Tour is on sealed country roads. Marshalls will be at key intersections in high visibility vests with directional signs.

There will be a stop for **morning tea at Sofala** provided by the Sofala Progress Association and a look around Historic Sofala.

Then onto **Historic Hill End and lunch** at the Royal Hotel. At its peak in the early 1870s Hill End had a population estimated at 8,000 served by 2 newspapers, 5 banks, 8 churches and 28 pubs. Spend some time wandering around the Historic town.

At Hill End the vehicles will be parked and displayed in various age categories. Here entrants will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite vehicle in each age category and people's choice. Trophies and prizes will be awarded at Saturday night's dinner.

SATURDAY NIGHT PRESENTATION DINNER

The venue will be the Bathurst RSL Club 114 Rankin Street. Pre-dinner drinks from 6.30pm followed by 2 course dinner at 7pm.

During the evening there will be trophy presentations, a short trivia quiz and raffle with great prizes on offer.
